

REGIONAL SUPPORT TO PROTECTION-SENSITIVE MIGRATION MANAGEMENT IN THE WESTERN BALKANS AND TURKEY

The overall objective of the action is to develop and operationalize a comprehensive migration management system in seven IPA beneficiary countries, namely Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Kosovo*, Montenegro, Serbia and Turkey, in line with EU standards. The specific objectives aim to facilitate and strengthen some of the key areas of a migration management system, focusing on enhancing the exchange of non-personal information in the region and; contribute to establishment of assisted voluntary mechanism in the beneficiary countries.

The action is complementary to the IPA II sister project led by Frontex “Regional Support to Protection-Sensitive Migration Management in the Western Balkans and Turkey” that focuses on identification mechanism and forced return. Both projects are part of the joint Action that is aiming to offer a comprehensive and holistic regional approach to mixed migration management complementing national efforts by providing a mixture of horizontal and regional support in the areas identified as the most urgent needs to be addressed.
